Tots Camp Information - Ages 3 - 5

Tots Camp is a program of recreation, education, and fun for children who have not yet entered kindergarten. Though it closely resembles a nursery school program, a distinct effort is made to make it seem camp-like rather than school-like, thus stressing fun and games and loosely framed outdoor activities. Despite this purpose, the program continues to be caring, and protective, in a well-supervised situation. The standards of safety, learning



and social responsibility are carefully maintained thus providing a satisfying experience for both campers and their families.

Each day the camp program will consist of an arts and craft project, outdoor playtime (weather permitting), sports, quiet time, music, story time, special events, and entertainment. On very warm days, there will be water play.

As part of our CIT program, our 9th and 10th grade CIT's learn how to work with children and staff in a closely supervised environment. Each day is divided between a field assignment and specials at the camp site
