Council Member Wolfensohn moved, seconded by Supervisor Gerrard to authorize the following resolution:

OPERATIONAL PLAN
FOR THE TEMPORARY USE OF CHAPPAQUA CROSSING
BY
NORTHERN WESTCHESTER HOSPITAL
FOR
EMPLOYEE ONLY PARKING

- 1) Parking for 140 NWH employees is to be limited to not more than 140 existing parking spaces in the parking area adjacent to the vehicle repair shop at the northern most portion of the site ("Permitted Parking Area.")
- 2) Employees of NWH are prohibited from entering the "Permitted Parking Area" between the hours of 7:00AM and 8:00AM.
- 3) Access to the "Permitted Parking Area" is to be gate controlled to prevent unauthorized use.
- 4) Shuttle van service utilizing two shuttle vans is to be provided by NWH to transport NWH employees to and from the "Permitted Parking Area" to NWH on a daily basis.
- 5) No shuttle van is to leave the Chappaqua Crossing site before 8:15AM on any day.
- 6) Shuttle van service will not operate between the hours of 9:45AM and 4:30 PM.
- 7) The last shuttle van will depart NWH at 5:45PM.
- 8) Mid-day or alternate hour transportation if required will be performed by a private taxi service or by using the Bee-Line bus service provided by Westchester County.
- 9) NWH will promote and continue to encourage to the greatest extent possible employee carpooling through the use of Metropool and NU-RIDE and existing public transportation to minimize traffic congestion around the Chappaqua Crossing site.
- 10) Any request by NWH to amend this plan consistent with Local Law #3 of 2008 must be made in writing to the New Castle Town Board.

- 11) The Town of New Castle reserves the right to alter this operational plan, after consultation in writing with NWH, so long as it is required by actual operating experiences and consistent with Local Law #3 of 2008.
- 12) This operational plan and the NWH right to use the Permitted Parking Area will expire on June 30, 2011 or at such time as the new parking structure at NWH is operational, whichever comes first.
